General

Balloons operated across land areas in which search and rescue would be especially difficult should be equipped with the following:

- 1. at least one ELT or a PLB;
- 2. signalling equipment for making distress signals; and
- 3. additional survival equipment adequate for the route to be flown taking account of the number of persons on board.

ADDITIONAL SURVIVAL EQUIPMENT

- 1. The following additional survival equipment should be carried:
 - 1. 500 ml of water for each four, or fraction of four, persons on board;
 - 2. one knife; and
 - 3. first-aid equipment.
- 2. If any item of equipment in (a) is already carried on board in accordance with other requirements, the carriage does not need to be duplicated.

AREAS IN WHICH SEARCH AND RESCUE WOULD BE ESPECIALLY DIFFICULT

The expression 'areas in which search and rescue would be especially difficult' means:

- 1. areas so designated by the authority responsible for managing search and rescue; or
- 2. areas that are largely uninhabited and where the authority referred to in (a):
 - 1. has not published any information to confirm whether search and rescue would be or would not be especially difficult; and
 - 2. does not, as a matter of policy, designate areas as being especially difficult for search and rescue.
