ML.A.905 Transfer of aircraft registration within the Union

Regulation (EU) 2019/1383

- 1. When transferring an aircraft registration within the Union, the applicant shall:
 - 1. first, provide the former Member State with the name of the Member State in which the aircraft will be registered;
 - 2. and subsequently apply to the new Member State for the issuance of a new airworthiness certificate in accordance with Annex I (Part-21) to Regulation (EU) No 748/2012.
- Notwithstanding point (a)(3) of point ML.A.902, the former ARC shall remain valid until its expiry date, except when the ARC was issued by independent certifying staff holding a national certifying-staff qualification in accordance with point (b)(4) of point ML.A.901, in which case point ML.A.906 shall apply.
- 3. Notwithstanding points (a) and (b), in those cases where the aircraft was in a non-airworthy condition in the former Member State or where the airworthiness status of the aircraft cannot be determined using the existing records, point ML.A.906 shall apply.
